## What do parents do?

Parents all around the country are experiencing the new joys (and tiny frustrations) of education. No worries, we will set everything up to make it as easy as possible for parents to implement. Parents' primary role will be to facilitate the place and provide the resources for their student.

1. Ensure your student has the materials and the proper place to engage in schoolwork.
2. Ensure your student is able to have access to the media resources (*Abeka ProTeach* & Zoom).
3. Pick up and drop off student work packets on a weekly basis (first 2 days of the week).

## How to start?

1. Designate a smart phone, tablet, laptop or computer to be your student's school device.
2. Download: Zoom (Video Conference App); or bookmark the website on an internet browser.
3. Bookmark the website: [atschool.abeka.com](http://atschool.abeka.com). This is the main access point for *Abeka ProTeach*.
4. The plan begins on April 20-21 by coming to the school and collecting your student materials and packet. School open hours are the first 2 days of the week, 8:00 - 11:00 AM.
